



Marine Room Uncorks New Program

La Jolla, Calif. - (February 20, 2008) – Effective February 22, 2008, The Marine Room will not charge a corkage fee for guests wishing to bring a special bottle of wine to enjoy with a celebratory or special occasion dinner. The complimentary corkage fee is limited to one bottle per table during dinner hours (and the bottle must be five years or older).

Previously, The Marine Room’s corkage fee was \$25 per bottle.

“I feel that corkage fees, which can range anywhere from \$10 to \$50 per bottle depending on the restaurant, have always been viewed by guests as negative,” states Marine Room general manager, Dennis Rush. “Opposite of conventional restaurant industry wisdom, we will now allow our guests to bring that special bottle of wine free of charge, which we hope will make for a more pleasurable dining experience.”

The Marine Room has also implemented a new designated driver incentive in which restaurant patrons who notify their server that they are the “DD” for the evening will be offered complimentary non-alcoholic beverages.
